Overview

Student will learn about a job of interest that relates to their education.

- A. Student will research the requirements for the job.
- B. Student will write a report including sources.
- C. Student will do a 5-minute presentation in class.

Answer the following questions and include sources where required. Some sources do not count; if you show your sources to me early enough I will review them with you.

- 1) Job Title (No sources required.)
- 2) What is it about this job that appeals to you? (No sources required.)
- 3) What kind of work is involved in this job? (Provide at least 2 sources.)
- 4) What do employers expect in terms of training or experience? (Provide at least 2 sources.)
- 5) What is the normal degree expected for this position? (Provide at least 2 sources.)
- 6) What is the highest required math for this degree? (Provide at least 1 source.)
- 7) Identify any internship, part-time or other opportunities that provide related experience prior to fulltime employment including deadlines and contact information. State if there are no deadlines listed. (Provide at least 1 source.)
- 8) Describe what you will do to become employable for this job. (No sources required.)

Submit a draft of your response to each question #1 through 8, including sources.

- +4 Each question #1 through 8 has the required sources as needed.
- +2 Up to two questions are missing the required sources or incomplete.
